INFORMATION DESK

If you have any questions or concerns, an information desk will be located right next to the pits. There will always be someone from the NTE team present.

CHECK IN

- Upon arrival, every team member will get a wristband to be able to access the area.
- Pits are available from Wednesday

CHECK OUT

- The campsite needs to be cleaned and then approved by representatives before leaving. Everything must be cleaned by 11:00 on June 29th.
- The pits must be empty and cleaned at 9:30 on June 29th.

MORNING BRIEFS

• Every morning during breakfast, there will be a brief with more detailed information about the day.

ALCOHOL

- No drinking alcohol during the day.
- No one who drives or tinkers with vehicles may be under the influence of alcohol.
- The area must be quiet at 22:00.

SAFETY

- Fire extinguishers and medical equipment are available in the pits
- Fire extinguishers need to be present next to your battery at all times.
- No running in the pits and no open shoes
- Reflective vest needs to be worn if you are on the track side of the concrete protection blocks.
- Medic is on site Friday to Saturday



GENERAL INFORMATION

CAMPING

Camping sites will be set up on the grass field just north of the test area, and showers and restrooms are close to the hangar and accessible for everyone. We will also have access to the middle section of the hangar. I've attached a map for you to get a clearer idea of the layout. Each team will get between 200 m2 and 300 m2 to camp.

There will be grills available for anyone who wishes to use them. Grilling is only allowed on the track after 18:00.

Teams are responsible for keeping their area of the camping clean, and there are garbage bins placed around the site. No alcoholic beverage bottles are allowed to be visible during the daytime.

HANGAR

- The hangar will be open from 07:00 to 21:00.
- In case of extreme weather the hangar will be open 24/7.

FOOD

- Breakfast is served every day from 7:30 to 08:30

TESTING AREA

- The testing area will be the large track area that is commonly used as a skidpan.
- We will alternate between different track setups upon request, see schedule.

PITS

- All teams will be provided with a 3x3m pit, teams who have an alumni car will receive an additional 3x3m space.



PIT/CAMPING LAYOUT

CAMPING



TRACK

PITS

- Each car/airplane/alumni car has a 3x3 m area,
- There will be electricity in the pits, use it with common sense, move outside of the tents if power tools are used.
- Storage areas should be used to store things that are weather sensitive.

CAMPING

- Each team will have between 200 m2 and 300 m2 camping space, depending on team size. These will be marked upon arrival.
- Showers are located between the hangars, see the map.
- Toilets will be scattered around the main site and next to the showers.
- Water can be refilled next to the showers.



SCRUTINEERING

To be allowed to drive, teams must pass the scrutineering.

Due to time limitations, we will only focus on things that have an impact on driver and member safety. Remember you drive at your own team's risk, NTE or Ljungbyhed take no responsibility for accidents caused by the car.

Scrutineering will be held on Friday morning from 9:00 to 13:00, with additional time available in the afternoon. The rough schedule is subject to change, but this would give you a rough estimate. There is also time on Thursday to perform scrutineering. If you and your team are ready earlier than Friday, please get in touch with Martin (+46722111715).

We encourage all teams to pre-scrut their cars before the event. We use the scrutineering guide document from FS Czech 2024.

EVENT RULES

ALL PARTICIPANTS ARE REQUIRED TO ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING SAFETY PROTOCOLS WITHOUT EXCEPTION. FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE REMOVAL FROM THE EVENT SITE. AGREEMENT TO THESE CONDITIONS ARE AGREED UPON ARRIVAL AT THE CAMP.

FIRE SAFETY

- Approved fire extinguishers and medical response equipment are stationed in the pits.
- A fire extinguisher must be positioned next to each battery at all times.

PERSONAL SAFETY AND CONDUCT IN PITS

- Running in pit areas is strictly prohibited.
- Open-toed footwear is not allowed in any technical or vehicle handling zone.

TRACKSIDE ACCESS

 A reflective safety vest must be worn at all times when entering the area beyond the concrete safety barriers.

MEDICAL PRESENCE

- A qualified nurse will be on site from Friday through Saturday.
- All injuries, regardless of perceived severity, must be reported to the info desk immediately.

ALCOHOL AND BEHAVIOUR POLICY

- No alcohol consumption is permitted during daylight or operational hours.
- Operating, testing or modifying any vehicle while under the influence of alcohol or drugs is strictly prohibited.
- Team members must have 0% alcohol in their blod if working on the car.
- No alcohol bevarage bottles are allowed to be visable during daytime.
- Quiet hours begin at 22:00. All teams must respect the rest and safety of others.

NON-COMPLIANCE

Failure to comply with any rule or failure to follow the instructions of event officials or safety personnel will result in the offending individual's immediate expulsion from the event grounds. Re-entry will not be permitted under any circumstance.



EMERGENCY PROTOCOL

IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY:

- Prioritize personal and team safety.
- Contact emergency services via 112 for any life-threatening incident.
- Notify the on-site medic immediately following emergency service contact.

SCENARIO 1: INJURY TO A PERSON

If the injury is apparently life-threatening, call 112. Otherwise call Martin (+46722111715) for medic response.

First aid kits are available in the hangars and at the info desk at the track.

SCENARIO 2: BATTERY MALFUNCTION

If a battery has not caught fire but looks to be on its way to combust, move it away from any other battery or building onto the tarmac/track and let it sit there.

Contact track marshall on tarmac/track.

SCENARIO 3: BATTERY FIRE

If a battery combusts, immediately evacuate the area and call 112.

SCENARIO 4: BRAWL

If for any reason attendees find themselves in a brawl, the fight should immediately be broken up and the people involved will be dismissed from the event site permanently.

SCENARIO 5: PERSON UNWELL DUE TO ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION

Move the person inside the hangar. Assess the state of the individual. If the individual is intoxicated to the point where they are not able to speak, their respective team leader should take them to a hospital. If their team leader is not in a drivable condition, anyone from the team who is, should drive them.
